We also commented that in Don's prayer that morning, among many other things, he told the Lord how thankful he was for such nice roads. Some of you will understand!

Reminiscing about all the happening of the past two months and the wonderful times we had with family and friends, it's been busy but awesome. How blessed we are. None of this would have taken place without Russ & Sherrie Cole. How wonderful to have such a willing and capable couple that would come and bless our children, and they did so much work while there! THANK YOU.

We want to tell you again thanks for all the beautiful cards and gifts and so many words of encouragement we received on our anniversary.

Rode and Petion came to the States last month to visit family and during that time Rode, six months into her pregnancy felt very lethargic. Petion took her to a clinic where they found her sugar count 500. They immediately sent her to the hospital where it took a week to get it under control. Before she was released they showed her how to take her blood count and give herself insulin, returning every few days. It was very traumatic for them as the Dr. thought he would have to take the baby to save the mother and they (with no insurance) are faced with a huge debt. She cannot return to Haiti until the baby is born. She is at such a risk. We've been in touch with her every day. Please keep her in your prayers. We are going to miss her when we return.

Include also in your special prayer Rachelle, who along with all her other responsibilities is doing Rode's work also. She is such a great gal--you will never hear one complaint from her. She is so very precious.

Please Include Ruben too as he so much wants to get married the end of this year. He has been looking at some property in Dessalines so he can be near the Orphanage.

We hear Pierre is doing better for which we praise the Lord. We will know more when we arrive. Please pray about the cost that was incurred during this tragedy and that he may return to the University soon. (He is the one who was hit by a car walking on the sidewalk in front of the University he attends in Haiti.)

Praise God for this season. Not only did Jesus die for our sins but Praise God he came out of that ole' dark tomb to give us life and even more abundantly. We are looking for His soon return. With all the signs we see coming to pass DAILY it can't be too far away. May we all be ready to go when He returns, other tombs are still occupied but the one that Jesus had is empty.

When it seems like there just won't be enough money to go around the Lord speaks to someone like this dear lady. She had been watching her retirement savings dwindle each month, but knew that if she gave it to EGO, it would multiply instead! We are very thankful to her and to the Lord for seeing to our every need.

Dad is looking forward to the end of May when Steve Schieb will be bringing in a small team to help him and assist the Haitian's in pouring the school's ceiling/2nd-story floor. After it is formed up, since it is so large (28 X 83), we will need to pour half one day and the other half the next day. Last year we were thinking this portion would be finished so we could be licensed by the Government. Please, with your prayers and support, will you help us finish this project? Thanks.

Our special thanks to Dr. Deb and Laurie for doing such a great work giving the children and employees physicals and helping us set up an ongoing inventory procedure.

We are returning to Haiti this week with 700# of cargo. Pray that God will give us strength and protection as we go into Haiti and Jacquelin and Ruben as they come in to pick us up. It will be good to get home.

How privileged we are that for all these years you have been faithful to Almighty God and to E.G.O. in your prayers and support. We have been blessed with people that have come and worked even though they had to work as in Nehemiah's day--with a sword in one hand and tools in the other. Can't you hear the Ram's horn blowing?!!!

Thanks so much, for without you we wouldn't be able to carry on the work that so many years ago God placed on our hearts. We stand amazed at how God has raised up these tiny little babies (now in the age range of 35!) to love the Lord with a heart that desires to see those growing up have the same values as they do, to be leaders and mentors for the Glory of God. We are so very Blessed.
