Our famous 12-year-old-boys trio sang, with beautiful harmony. They were followed by a song with their entire age group. We were so very proud of them. Our church choir sang and then the Baptist Choir sang beautifully.

After the service, as they were praying for the sick I felt impressed to lay little Keuchia on the altar. I went back to where she was sitting and talked with her mother. (Yes, after much persuasion from everyone, Junette finally brought Keuchia in from out in the country. She has been staying at her mothers, who is not a Christian and who is, of course, very superstitious. She believes that a health drink we had given Keuchia had made her worse and didn't want her to come here again.) Junette went down and laid the little one on the altar. I interpreted for the pastor and wife. He was explaining how the work had all been done on the cross. She hadn't exactly been the mother she should be, and she cried and prayed, asking forgiveness. Thank you, Jesus. Keuchia is somewhat worse than before. Please keep her and her mom, Junette, in your prayers.

There were also those who were so much a part of the preparation for the day. **Rode** made beautiful decorations for the walls of the tabernacle for the service. Also, **Miralaine** made many Patties (a pastry with meat filling) along with a delicious cake. God is so good to give us such great talent coming out of the orphanage. School is in progress. We are in need of sponsors for quite a few children that aren't able to pay any tuition.

The beginning of next year Dad is looking forward to some teams coming to pour the columns on the second floor. Also he plans to dig the foundation for the next wing. He has many other projects in the planning stages.
